## **The early Labor Movement in Yorke Peninsula's Copper Mining Industry 1864-1907**

This talk focusses on the copper mining industry on Yorke Peninsula, a major centre of the emergent Labor movement in South Australia in the second half of the nineteenth century and the early twentieth century.

It examines the importance of Cornish ethno-occupational and ethno-religious identity in shaping the strikes of 1864, 1874 and 1892, and discusses the emergence of local trade unionism and a political Labor movement, leading to representation in the South Australian Parliament.
