## **Heritage Weekend – Copper Coast**

The Society's executive has decided to gauge members feelings on the proposed heritage visit to the former copper towns of Wallaroo and Moonta on the 22<sup>nd</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2004. There are three options you are asked to choose from.

### **OPTION "A"**

A visit to the Copper coast towns over the abovementioned weekend, which includes, a bus tour from Adelaide to the Copper Coast and return, an overnight stay at Moonta (Moonta Bay Patio Motel, if available), a set three course dinner (drinks extra), a cooked breakfast on the Sunday morning and one lunch and all museum entrance fees included for a total cost of \$170 per person, \$340 per double.

### **OPTION "B"**

A single day visit on either the Saturday or Sunday of the abovementioned weekend, including the bus tour from Adelaide to the Copper Coast and return, lunch (drinks extra) and entrance to all museums visited included for a cost of \$80 per person.

### **OPTION "C"**

Go back to the drawing board. Not interested.

For the heritage visit to be financially viable under either OPTIONS A or B, we need at least 30 firm expressions of interest in favour of going on tour.

Therefore members should notify the secretary as soon as possible, as to which of the three option's they prefer.
